The Newfoundland Republican Association Party

The confederation of Newfoundland with Canada has been a failure. Newfoundland is just a slave of the Laurentian Elite. The NRA party would restructure Government Bureaucracy. It would start by eliminating its deadwood. Empires within the bureaucracy would be dismantled. The NRA party would support Small Business Enterprises with potential for major job creation. It would provide strong support for Local Production of Food. Medical diagnosis and treatment is recipe driven. These recipes can be encapsulated into software. MUN and CNA would develop such software for medical clinics in small coastal communities. This would allow people in these communities to take care of themselves.
